

Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH)

Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH) is the flagship hospital of the National Healthcare Group and part of Singapore's Public Healthcare System. As a pioneering hospital with strong roots in the community for over 178 years, TTSH is recognised as the People's Hospital, serving a resident population of 1.4 Million living in Central Singapore.

As one of the largest multi-disciplinary hospitals in Singapore, TTSH operates more than 1700 beds with centres of excellence including the National Centre for Infectious Diseases (NCID). Together, with 70 community partners and 80 community health posts, it brings care beyond the hospital into the community as an integrated care organisation- Central Health.

ANAESTHETIST

The Department of Anaesthesiology, Intensive Care and Pain Medicine is a national leader in Neuroanesthesia and Neurocritical care, Surgical Intensive care as well as Regional Anaesthesia. We provide anaesthetic services to 24 operating theatres (OT) in the hospital as well as the endoscopy and radiological suites.

The applicant will be responsible for providing anaesthesia care to patients in the perioperative period. In addition, you are expected to provide pre-operative evaluation, preparation & counselling to patients in the Pre-Admission Assessment, Counselling & Evaluation (PACE) Clinic and management of acute pain after surgery. You will also have the opportunity to be involved in clinical research as well as teaching of medical students, junior and senior residents during the course of the work in the department.

OPHTHALMOLOGIST (VITREO-RETINAL SURGEON)

The Department of Ophthalmology provide ophthalmic outpatient, inpatient, laser, LASIK and surgery services at tertiary and subspecialty levels.

The applicant must be experienced in general ophthalmology, in addition to having a well-developed special interest in vitreo-retinal surgery. The scope of work includes the treatment of retinal detachment, macular hole, epiretinal membrane and complications related to diabetic retinopathy. The applicant must also be fellowship-trained in vitreo-retinal surgery.

THORACIC SURGEON

The Thoracic Surgery Service, Department of General Surgery has a busy and growing thoracic surgical practice that provides coverage for Public Healthcare Institutions within NHG.

The applicant should be proficient in all aspects of general thoracic surgery. Experience in minimally invasive procedures is preferred. Applicants must be committed to a career that combines outstanding patient care with excellent teaching and research activities. A key component of the position will involve teaching medical students as well as residents in both General Surgery and Cardiothoracic Surgery residency programs.

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must possess a basic Medical Degree and recognised post-graduate qualification; MMed, FRCS, FRACS, FRCSC, Board Cert or its equivalent, which is registrable with the Singapore Medical Council. You must also have completed a recognised advanced specialist training programme in the above specialities and be eligible to be accepted for accreditation by Specialist Accreditation Board (SAB) with Ministry of Health (MOH).
