The following genes were evaluated in the genetic analysis for our patient:

complement factor H (*CFH*), complement factor B (*CFB*), complement factor I (*CFI*), membrane cofactor protein (*MCP*), complement C3 (*C3*), complement factor H related 1 (*CFHR1*), complement factor H related 3 (*CFHR3*), complement factor H related 5 (*CFHR5*), diacylglycerol kinase epsilon (*DGKE*), and metabolism of cobalamin associated C (*MMACHC*).
